Adult Secondary Education Classes focus on preparing students to take and pass the five HiSET® (formerly GED) tests in order to earn a Massachusetts High School Equivalency Certificate. The HiSET® tests are in the areas of Language Arts Reading, Language Arts Writing, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies.

Attendance Policy: Students are expected to be in class and on time everyday. If a participant cannot attend, he/she must call in. All students must read and sign a copy of the Attendance Agreement.

Counseling: Counseling is available both days and evenings. Problems (personal or school related) may be discussed with a program counselor.
