Adult Basic Education Classes focus on reading, writing, and math skills while integrating technology, social studies, science, and health within three levels:

- *Level (0-3.9)*, Beginner Level, focuses on reading using a variety of strategies to meet the needs and learning styles of the participants.
- *Level (4-5.9)*, Intermediate Level, focuses on the development of skills to enable participants to increase skills and attain goals for advancement.
- *Level (6-8.9)*, Advanced Level, prepares students to progress to HiSET and/or GED Preparation or the Adult Diploma Program.

Attendance Policy: Students are expected to be in class and on time everyday. If a participant cannot attend, he/she must call in. All students must read and sign a copy of the Attendance Agreement.

Educational & Career Advising: Advising is available both days and evenings. Issues, questions, difficulties (personal or school related) may be discussed with a program counselor.

Volunteer Tutors: Volunteer tutors enable our program to offer small group instruction.

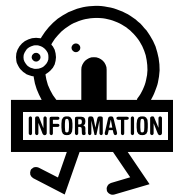
