Adult Secondary Education Classes focus on preparing students to take and pass the HiSET® and or GED test in order to earn a Massachusetts High School Equivalency Certificate. The HiSET® tests are in the areas of Language Arts Reading, Language Arts Writing, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies whereas the GED tests are Mathematics, Reading Language Arts, Science and Social Studies.

Attendance Policy: Students are expected to be in class and on time everyday. If a participant cannot attend, he/she must call in. All students must read and sign a copy of the Attendance Agreement.

Educational and Career Advising: Advising services are available both days and evenings. Issues/questions/difficulties (personal or school related) may be discussed with a program advisor.
