FREE Classes

Four levels of **English for Speakers of Other Languages Classes** are offered which focus on use at home, work, and in the community. All ESOL classes also incorporate math, science, technology, history, social sciences, and health into the curriculum.

- **Level One** focuses on development of English oral comprehension and basic conversation skills.
- **Level Two** also focuses on oral skills but includes reading and writing English.
- **Level Three** increases the focus on reading and writing while improving oral skills.
- **Level Four** incorporates the development of higher-level writing, vocabulary and reading skills as well as refining oral skills.

All ESOL classes use real world materials to assist learners in increasing skills in their roles as a family member, community member, and worker.

Attendance Policy: Participants are expected to be in class on time everyday. If a learner cannot attend, he or she must call in.

Educational & Career Advising: Advising services are available both days and evenings at all class locations. A counselor is also available at the Career Center. If you have an issue, question or difficulties (personal or school related), you may speak to an advisor.

Volunteer Tutors: Volunteer tutors enable us to offer small group instruction.
