You've taken the first step toward your future goals.

In order to earn a New Bedford High School, Evening Extension Diploma, you must:

Forward an official transcript of previous high school courses *and* MCAS Scores (if applicable) to the NBHS, Evening Extension Program.

Meet with a program counselor, available during registration, for an evaluation of your transcript and to determine a "Program of Study."

Pass the MCAS Exam (English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science) and provide official documentation of your scores.

MCAS STE includes one of the following:

Biology, Chemistry, Introductory Physics, or Technology/Engineering

MCAS Retest Exam Dates/Fees:

Sign up with a program counselor as soon as possible. Testing dates for the 2018 - 2019 school-year are as follows:

ELA: November 8, 9, & 13, 2018 - \$40

Math: November 14 & 15, 2018 - \$30

STE Biology: February 6 & 7, 2019 - \$30

(STE: Science, Technology & Engineering)

ELA: March 4, 5 & 6, 2019 - \$40

Graduation Requirements:

- Attain 20 units. (Official transcripts must be evaluated by a program counselor and approved by the program principal.)
- Successfully pass:
 - English I, II, III, IV
 - U.S. History I & II
 - Remaining units are electives
- Enroll and successfully complete a minimum of two courses with the Evening Extension Program.
- Achieve a passing score on the MCAS English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science Exams as per MDESE and satisfy the requirements of the Educational Proficiency Plan.
- **Exit interview with program counselor and principal. (Approval of credit schedule by principal)**
- All accounts must be paid in full including **graduation fee!**

Units can also be earned/awarded:
 (Units awarded upon approval.)

- Satisfactory score on the placement exam (up to four units)
- Proficiency in Portuguese or Spanish (maximum of two units)
- Employment (documentation required)
- College courses (approval and official documentation required)
- Training Programs (approval and official documentation required)
- Military Service (official documentation required)
- Community Service (site approval, documentation and report required)
