Congratulations on your decision to enroll in the New Bedford High School Evening Extension Program!!! You've taken the first step toward attaining your future goals!

Over the last 57 years adults have enrolled to earn a high school credential, complete pre-requisite requirements for college and/or training programs, to increase skills for employment or for self-improvement purposes!!! It will be our pleasure to work with you in attaining your goals!

The New Bedford High School Evening Extension Program operates on a Trimester Basis and class offerings may vary each trimester. Trimester I operates from September – November; Trimester II operates from November – February; Trimester III operates from March – May.

To register, please complete the registration form and mail it back with payment. Tuition and fees are: New Bedford residents \$120 per course, Out of town residents \$180 per course. (Personal Checks not accepted!) If your intent is to earn a credential with NBHS Evening Extension, please follow the steps listed below.

In order to earn a New Bedford High School Evening Extension Diploma and register for classes, you must:

1. Contact your last high school to request an official transcript of previous high school courses and MCAS Scores be sent directly to **Mrs. Wilde, Principal, New Bedford High School Evening Extension Program.**
2. Schedule an appointment with a program counselor, available during registration for an evaluation of your transcript and to develop a "Program of Study." Registration Dates: November 9, 10, 16, 18 and 23, 2020. Appointments available evenings at NBHS between 5:45 and 8:15 p.m. (Limited class slots!!)

MCAS Retest Exam Dates/Fees:

Dates for the 2020-2021 school-year have not yet been confirmed by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (MDESE). Testing may take place in January and May for the ELA and Math. The MCAS STE may take place in February. Fees for MCAS: ELA - \$40; Math - \$30; STE Biology \$30

Graduation Requirements:

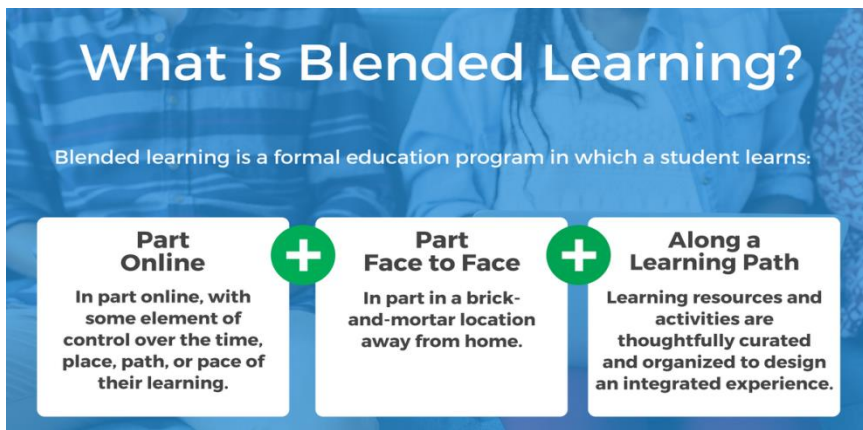
- Attain 20 units. (Official transcripts must be evaluated by a program counselor and approved by the program principal.)
- Successfully pass: English I, II, III, IV; U.S. History I & II (Remaining units are electives.)
- Enroll and successfully complete a minimum of two courses with the Eve. Ext. Program.
- Achieve passing scores on the MCAS Exams (English Language Arts, Mathematics, and STE*) and provide official documentation of your scores. {*MCAS STE includes one of the following: Biology, Chemistry, Introductory Physics or Technology/Engineering} as well as fulfill the requirements of the Educational Proficiency Plan as per MDESE.
- Schedule and complete an Exit Interview with a program counselor and principal which includes approval of your program of study/credit schedule.
- All accounts must be paid in full including the graduation fee regardless of participation in the annual graduation.

Units can also be earned/awarded:

- Satisfactory score on the placement exam (up to four units)
- Proficiency in Portuguese or Spanish (maximum of two units)
- Employment (documentation required)
- College courses (approval and official documentation required)
- Training Programs (approval and official documentation required)
- Military Service (official documentation required)
- Community Service (site approval, documentation and report required)

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the structure and schedule of classes has been modified.

- All courses will be offered through a **Blended Learning Model** unless conditions change requiring all classes to shift to a Distance Learning Model (online only).



- Courses will be conducted on either a Monday or Wednesday evening according to the schedule for 2.25 hours per week (Face to Face: 6:30 – 8:45 p.m.), will also require an online learning session each week as well as homework. {Class time (face to face) and online = 3 hours minimally of instruction as well as homework in addition to instruction.}
- Participants may register for two courses by taking a Monday course and a Wednesday course. Each course will require online learning sessions/assignments.
- Due to this change in model, **participants are required to have a Gmail address for school communications, a reliable device and Internet access** to fully participate and earn credit.

Leaners are responsible to:

- Complete all class work
- Check in with the course instructor each week
- Complete all related online assignments
- Complete homework assignments
- Remain up to date on coursework

Grades: Students will earn a letter grade based on the quality of completed assignments and assessments.

It is important to note, due to health concerns, all students must adhere to CDC guidelines and NBPS policies which includes frequent hand washing/sanitizer use, **masks** which are **required** upon entrance to the facility and use throughout class time and dismissal. Social distancing must also be adhered to at all times.

- *It is best to stay home if you have a fever, cough or other symptoms of COVID-19!*
- **These guidelines will be strictly enforced.**

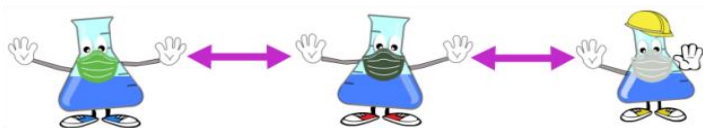
